### Tuition Assistance

Any families seeking Tuition Assistance must contact the School Office in advance of the school year in order to complete the required application and be approved before acceptance into the school. A new application must be completed for any subsequent year in advance of the school year for which tuition assistance is being sought.

### Academic Fees

(per K-8 student)

<b>\$25.00 General Fee:</b>	For the purchase of supplies used throughout the year.
<b>\$15.00 Activity &amp; Health Fee:</b>	For health room supplies and maintenance of the field.
<b>\$35.00 Reading Fee:</b>	Supports the Reading program.
<b>\$42.00 Technology Fee:</b>	Supports the technology program.
<b>\$25.00 Rediker Fee:</b>	Required archdiocesan administrative program for all Catholic schools.
<b>\$40.00 Archdiocesan Fee:</b>	For the Office of Catholic Schools to support the work of the archdiocesan office.
<b>\$ 5.00 Fine Arts Fee:</b>	For art and music supplies.
<b>\$ 5.00 Curriculum Fee:</b>	Provides K-5 students with Weekly Readers or Scholastic Magazines and Jr. High students with Junior Scholastic Science and Scholastic Art.

### Assessment Fee

(per family)

**\$200.00**, payable in two payments: \$100.00 in October 2018; \$100.00 in March 2019.

### Payment Policy

- A. A \$30.00 returned draft fee will be added to your account.
- B. All balances and returned draft charges must be paid in order to register for the coming year and in order to receive report cards, diplomas and transcripts.

### Requirements

- A. Birth, Baptismal, and Immunization certificates for Kindergarten and new students in school.
- B. Prior to admission a copy of the last report card (Grade 1-8) and any psychological evaluations must be submitted for review.
- C. By Sept. 10, 2018, students entering K4 must be 4 years old, and students entering Kindergarten must be 5 years old.
- D. Health Regulations: Per Alabama's Mandatory School Immunization Law, ALL NEW STUDENTS, regardless of grade, must have a Certificate of Immunization before they can be admitted to the School for the fall semester, 2018. NEW students must have completed the required series of immunizations, and must have obtained a Certificate of Immunization before they can enter or return to the classroom for the 2018-2019 school year. This Certificate of Immunization may be obtained from the Mobile County Health Department (690-8157) or from your private physician. The immunizations required for a Certificate are as follows:

**Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis**, (DTP, DT, OR TD)

**Vaccine** — at least three doses.

**Polio Vaccine** — at least three doses of Trivalent Oral Polio Vaccine.

**Varicella (chickenpox) Vaccine** — Grades K through 8.

**Measles Vaccine** — two doses (Grades K through 12)\*

**Mumps Vaccine** — one dose\*

*\*The Measles, Rubella, and Mumps vaccines can be administered together as a single injection.*

**Tdap** — Grades 6 through 8.

Since some of the above must be administered over a period of time, we encourage parents to look into this as soon as possible so as to avoid problems in the future. All students who intend to enroll in Corpus Christi next year should have the required Certificate of Immunization on file with the School no later than August 1, 2018.

**A Registration Fee of \$100.00 per student is payable upon notification of acceptance.**

Registration fees and all other fees are non-refundable.
